The following table summarises changes to biodiversity-related legislation and policy since 2003 (Source: Scott (2013) Review of the Sutherland Biodiversity Action Plan). It is not a comprehensive list, but illustrates the extent to which the background to biodiversity work is constantly changing. In the nine years since the first Highland BAP was published, considerable progress has been made across the board, (from Directives of the European Community to the responsibilities of the Highland Council), in integrating consideration for biodiversity into mainstream policy and legislation.

The Primary source of the data is the spreadsheet 'Scottish Biodiversity Ecosystem Groups and the BAP priority species and habitats which occur in and across them'. It is available at <http://www.biodiversityscotland.gov.uk/library/Ecosystem%20Groups%20BAP%20priority%20Species%20&%20Habitats.xls>, and was downloaded on 7 January 2010. That is the subset of UKBAP species that are considered by the Scottish Biodiversity Group to occur in Scotland.

The Highland list has been derived and flagged in the first instance from the following sources:

- *Non-littoral marine species*, the MarLIN site <http://www.marlin.ac.uk> (if Highland appears within the observed or the expected range, the species is flagged as present in Highland);
- *All other taxa*, NBN Gateway maps. Absence of a dot was confirmed with other sources, except in the case of most moths (a well-studied group in Highland).

No verification of individual records has been done. Websites were accessed between 7 and 12 April 2010. If presence or absence could not be firmly established from these sources, other authoritative sources were consulted and a comment added. Please refer to the full spreadsheet on the website for full species list (including those not known to be present in Highland) and source information.
