What would encourage you to use public transport more often?



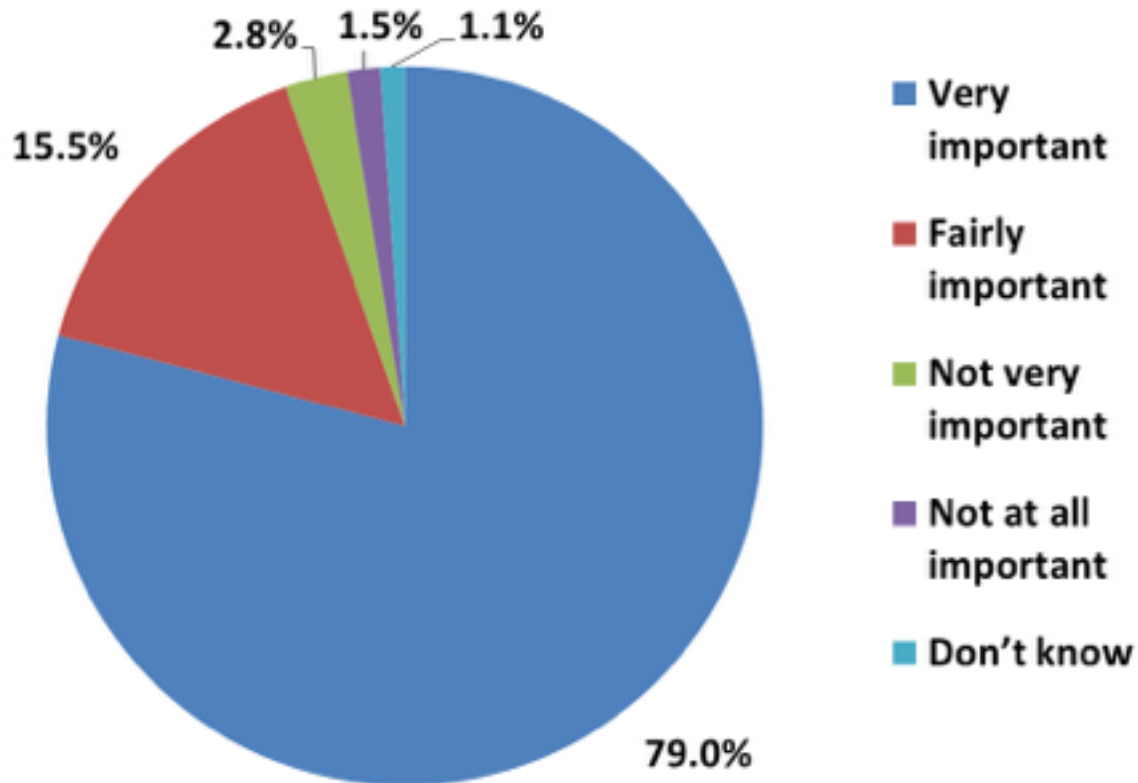

What would encourage you to purchase an electric/ hybrid car in place of a standard petrol/ diesel car?

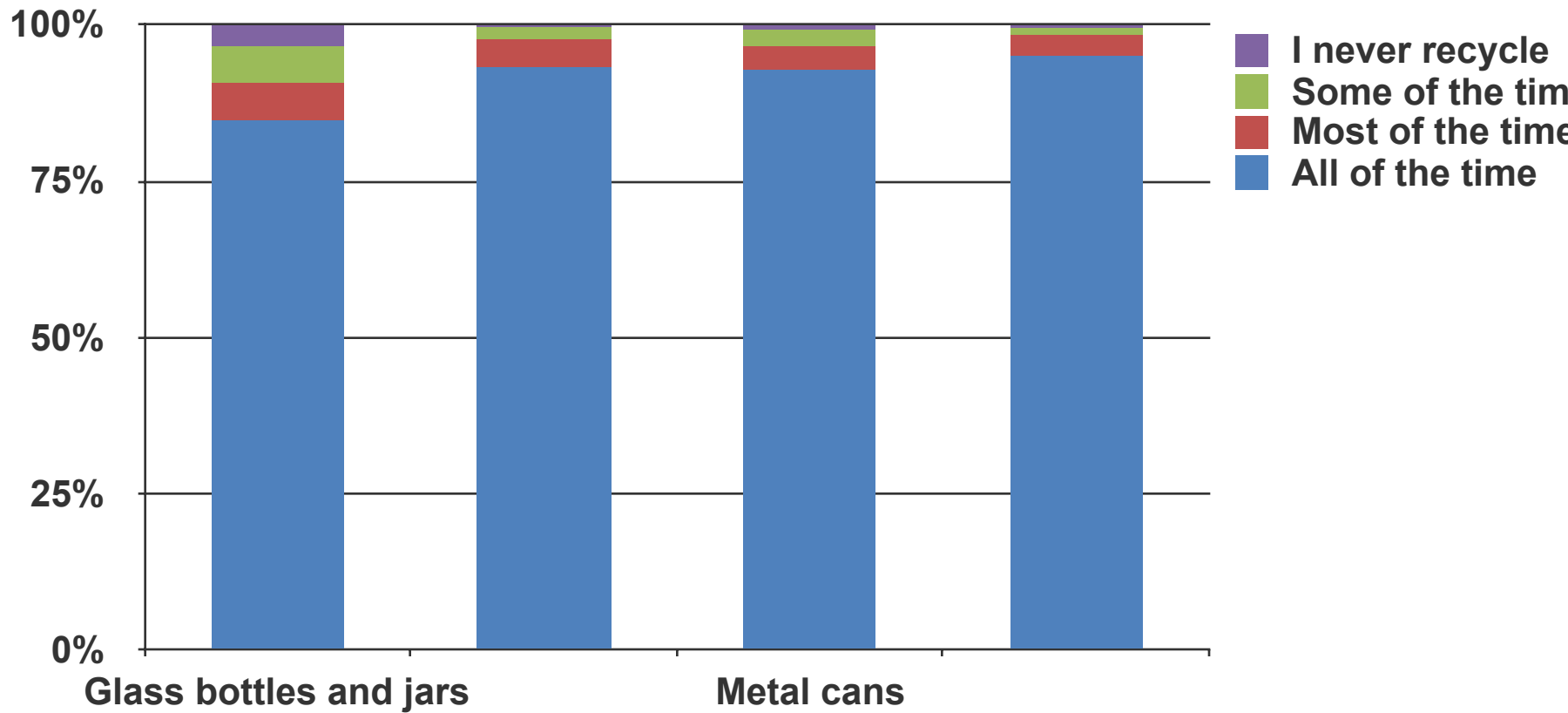

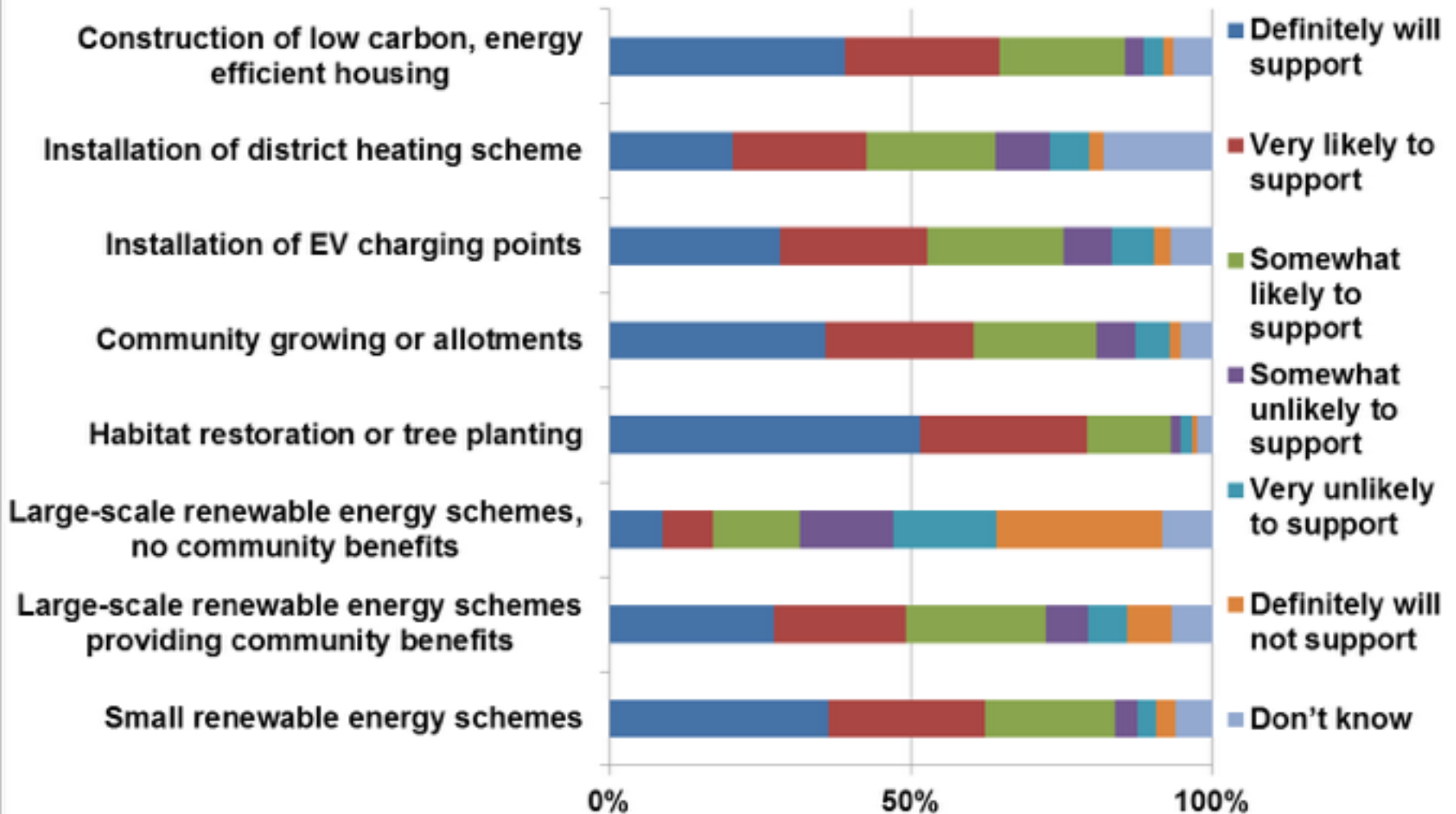
How important, if at all, is it to you to have public gardens, parks, countryside or other green spaces nearby?

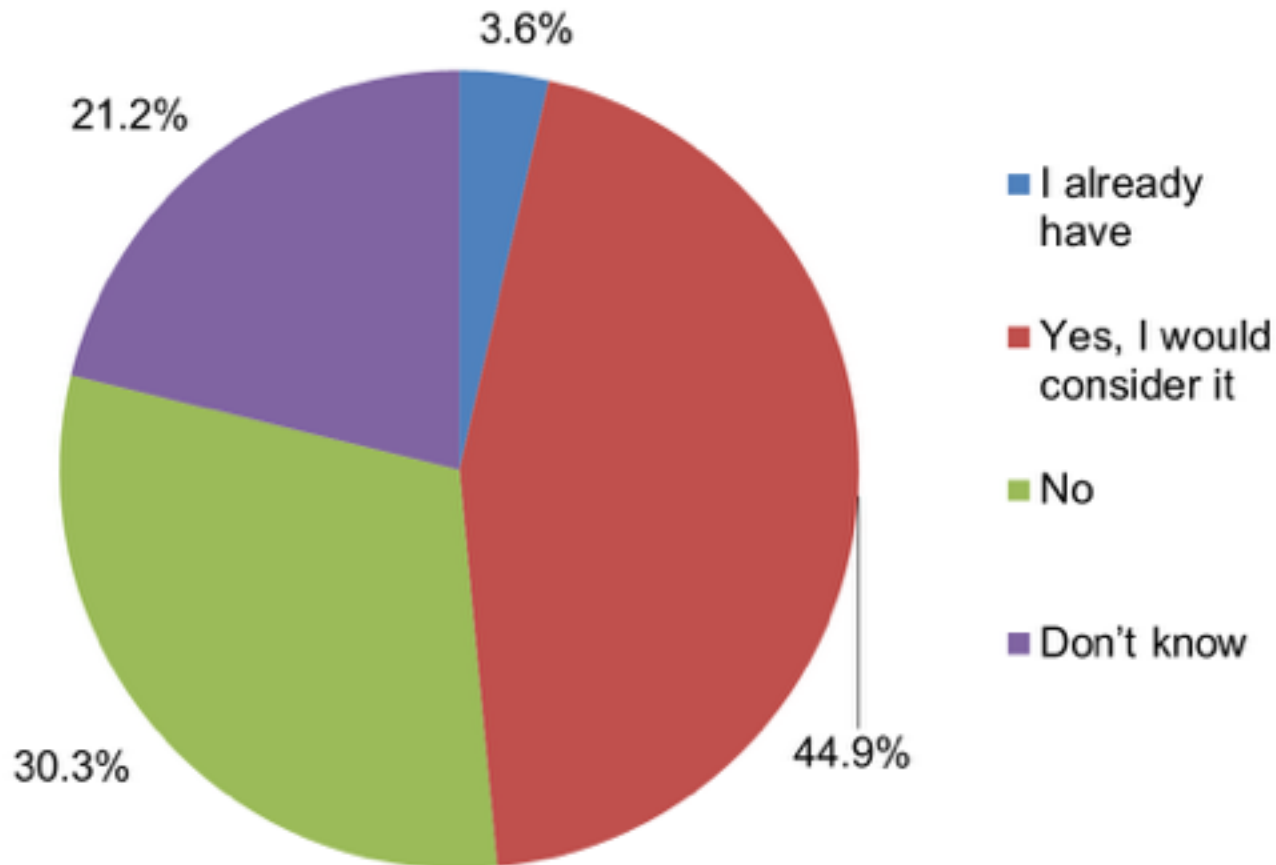
